- \$80 million for housing assistance, green job creation and development
- Funding opportunities: direct

**DEPARTMENT OF  
HOUSING AND  
COMMUNITY AFFAIRS**

- \$350 million for weatherization assistance
- Funding opportunities: direct, competitive, block grant

**DEPARTMENT OF  
HEALTH AND  
HUMAN SERVICES**

- \$330 million for health information technology
- Funding opportunities: direct, competitive, block grant

**DEPARTMENT OF  
TRANSPORTATION**

- \$2.5 million for construction, job creation and placement of 100,000 new workers
- Funding opportunities: direct

**COMPTROLLER  
(State Energy  
Conservation)**

- \$238 million to SEP for building infrastructure; energy efficiency, and renewable energy projects
- Funding opportunities: direct, competitive, block grant

**WORKFORCE  
COMMISSION  
(Labor)**

- \$213 million for youth, adult, and dislocated worker services; Wagner-Peysner grants; community older worker programs
- Funding opportunities: direct, competitive, block grant

**PUBLIC UTILITY  
COMMISSION**

- Assistant Secretary of Commerce for Communications and Information has grant money to strengthen Community Colleges' computer centers and library technology
- Funding opportunities: competitive

**DEPARTMENT OF  
AGRICULTURE**

- Federal department has grant money available to expand distant learning technology and training at Community Colleges
- Funding opportunities: competitive

**TEA  
(Higher Ed)**

- \$3 billion primarily to local school districts for a myriad of education, job training, and on-site workshop projects
- Funding opportunities: competitive and block grant
